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How to use this document

Complete section 1 with your property manager before the season starts, agree sections 2-4 with your contractor in writing, and use section 6 as the record of every response event. Insurers and municipalities decide slip-and-fall and bylaw disputes on documentation.

1. Site profile (complete before November 1)

- ☐ Property address and site contact, with a 24-hour phone number
- ☐ Total public sidewalk length in scope (linear feet)
- ☐ Entries, vestibule aprons, and stair landings in scope
- ☐ Accessible routes, ramps, and curb cuts in scope
- ☐ Parking lanes, drive aisles, and loading bays in scope
- ☐ Parkade ramp apron and grade — flag if it freezes first
- ☐ Designated snow stockpile locations, clear of drains and hydrants
- ☐ Surfaces requiring low-chloride product (new concrete, pavers, planting)
- ☐ Salt bin locations and re-stock responsibility

2. Response triggers

- ☐ Accumulation trigger agreed in writing (2 cm is the commercial default)
- ☐ Anti-icing pre-treatment trigger (forecast freezing with precipitation)
- ☐ Freezing-rain response protocol agreed separately from snowfall
- ☐ Re-check pass interval during multi-day events
- ☐ After-hours escalation contact on both sides

3. Priority sequence and deadlines

- ☐ Accessible routes, ramps, and curb cuts — first
- ☐ Primary building entries and stair landings — second
- ☐ Public sidewalks — cleared before the municipal deadline
- ☐ Parking lanes, drive aisles, loading bays — after occupancy routes
- ☐ Target completion time before first occupancy (e.g. 06:00)

Note: City of Vancouver and most Metro Vancouver municipalities require adjacent public sidewalks to be cleared by 10:00 AM the day following a snowfall. Confirm the deadline in your municipality.



4. Product selection

- ☐ Standard salt approved on asphalt and mature concrete
- ☐ Low-chloride or magnesium-based product specified near new concrete, pavers, landscaping, and pet-traffic areas
- ☐ Application rate calibrated to surface temperature, not applied by eye
- ☐ Run-off and storm-drain protection considered at low points
- ☐ Traction grit specified where de-icer is ineffective below its working temperature

5. Compliance and insurance file

- ☐ Certificate of liability insurance on file, current for the season
- ☐ WorkSafeBC clearance letter on file
- ☐ Written winter service agreement with scope, triggers, and deadlines
- ☐ Contractor's photo and time-stamp logging method confirmed
- ☐ Season-end archive of all service logs retained by the property

6. Service-log template (one row per response event)

Record for every visit:

Date | Arrival time | Departure time | Air / surface temperature

Conditions on arrival | Accumulation cleared

Areas cleared (entries / sidewalks / accessible routes / parking)

Product applied | Quantity applied | Application rate

Re-check pass performed (Y/N) and time

Photos taken before and after (file reference)

Crew lead name and signature

7. Season review

- ☐ Total response events and total seasonal cost recorded
- ☐ Missed deadlines or complaints logged with root cause
- ☐ Incidents or claims logged, with the matching service log attached
- ☐ Scope adjustments identified for next season
- ☐ Contract model reviewed (per-event vs fixed seasonal)
